



What should Flexi-Boarders bring to school?

Although we can provide them, Flexi-Boarders might like to bring in a duvet cover and pillowcase of their own, properly named, which will then be kept and laundered at school.

Each time they board, Flexi-Boarders must bring the following into school in a small, clearly named overnight bag.

Every Stay

- ☐ Pyjamas
Bottoms must be mid-thigh to full length for being around the house before bed. Shorter pyjama shorts can be worn once in bed.
- ☐ Dressing gown and slippers or sliders
Must be suitable for wearing outside in any weather.
- ☐ Towel
- ☐ Clean underwear, socks or tights, and a shirt for each day of their stay
- ☐ One set of play clothes
- ☐ Reading book
- ☐ Teddy
If required.

Toilet Bag

- ☐ Toothbrush and toothpaste
- ☐ Shower gel and shampoo
- ☐ Comb and hair bobbles or grips (girls)
- ☐ Shower cap (girls)

Boarders may also wish to bring a photo (6" x 4") for their photo frame, along with additional photos and posters to decorate the pin boards.

Storing Boarding Bags

Flexi-Boarders who have only one night at home between boarding nights, or who board three nights a week, may leave their boarding bag neatly stored under their bed on nights when they are not boarding.

Children who have more than one night at home between boarding nights, or who board only one night a week, must not leave anything in their bedroom (towels, slippers and so on) between the nights they board or over the weekends. They may, of course, leave photos and posters in the dorm.

Please note: aerosols must not be brought into school. Mobile phones, money, tuck and electrical items such as tablets must not be brought in either. If something is brought in by accident, please hand it to the Matrons, Houseparents or duty member of boarding staff.
